Arrangements on Deferral of Class Resumption for All Schools

Dear Parents,

According to the guideline from the Centre for Health Protection (CHP) and the emergency plan of the Government and in view of an increase in the number of confirmed and suspected Novel Coronavirus infection cases and the increasing risk of the spread of the virus in crowded environment in a short period of time as many people travel abroad and visit relatives during the Chinese New Year holidays, the Education Bureau announced that all schools will further defer class resumption, that is, schools will not resume classes before 20th April 2020 to safeguard students' health. In order to prevent and control the spread of infectious diseases, our school have carried out various hygiene measures, such as through disinfection cleaning of classroom, school facilities and venues. It is of prime importance that children with fever (oral temperature higher than 37.5° C, or ear temperature higher than 38° C), cough, sore throat, runny nose, muscle pain, tiredness, headache, vomiting or diarrhea, regardless of the presence of respiratory symptom, they should be advised to seek medical advice immediately.

Please follow the following measures:

- 1. All students who have traveled abroad should return to Hong Kong before 6th April 2020 (Saturday).
- 2. For students who have traveled to mainland China during the holidays are required to be quarantined at home for 14 days.
- 3. All students must declare their health condition and recent travelling and complete the "Travel Record Sheet".(If it has been filled in, don't care)
- 4. All students should not travel to mainland China or other countries during school suspension.
- 5. The "Parents Meeting Day" will be canceled, teacher will phone to parents.
- 6. All school activities will be re-scheduled and announced at a later stage.
- 7. Our school will provide e-learning platform during the period of school suspension, parents are required to accompany your children during the e-learning:
 - a) theme learning by class teacher
 - b) e-learning on virus preventive measures / EVI-GARTEN-self learning on virus
 - c) I-can electronic class

Remarks:

During the period of school suspension, parents are suggested to monitor your children to complete the home exercises. Parents are required to collect their home exercises in the following schedule:

Date : K.1 Classes ~ 16th March 2020 (Monday)

K.2 Classes ~ 17th March 2020 (Tuesday)

K.3 Classes ~ 18th March 2020 (Wednesday)

Time : 1:00pm to 4:00pm

*If you cannot come to collect the home exercise at the above time, you may come at 9:00am to 1:00pm on any other day.
